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ABSTRACT RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Individuals are allowed to submit more than one abstract (with different position as first author, corresponding author or other author). Maximum 3 abstracts
2. Abstract is submitted by the corresponding author (CA).
3. A reviewed paper or research paper only can be submitted
4. Abstracts must be submitted electronically through the conference website's abstract submission system.
5. Previously published abstracts (in print or electronically) or those presented at another meeting are not allowed.
6. An abstract should be 250 words or less with a Title limit to 15 words or less. Please capitalize the first letter of each word in the Title.
7. Each abstract is required to have: Background(s), Objective(s), Method(s), Result(s), and Conclusion(s)
8. Images, tables, diagrams, graphs are not allowed in the abstracts text.
9. Keywords: All abstract submissions may select up to five keywords from a list.
10. Authors: name, department, institutions, country. Mark (*) first author and corresponding author (**) with email address of corresponding author.

Any work with human or animal subjects described in the abstract complies with the World Medical Association's Declaration of Helsinki's guiding principles for experimental procedures, and the research project has been approved by an Institutional Review Board, Institutional Ethics Committee, or an equivalent ethical body.

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12. Awards: Each abstract submitted has the option of pursuing an awards competition.
13. Type of article (review literature or research) must be selected during the submission process. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to change the category during the abstract assessment process
14. The submission deadline for the abstract is on May 31, 2024, at 11.59 pm (Western Indonesia Time)
15. Official notifications in the form of a letter of acceptance will be delivered to corresponding author on June 15, 2024, through email.
16. The first author is the one who presents the paper and receives the certificate.
17. A letter of invitation including presentation mode, date, session time, and presentation number will be issued after registration and payment have been made through email.
18. The mode of abstract acceptance will be Accepted (A), Accepted with Revision (AR), and Rejected (R).
19. If accepted, the author may proceed to the registration link and make the payment and proceed to follow the paper guidelines.
20. If the authors are willing to publish the paper can proceed to follow the paper guidelines.
